On behalf of the Arbutus Lake Association (ALA) and those dedicated to preserving this Lake for all to enjoy, we invite you to read the following rules, regulations, and information associated with the safe boating habits practiced on Arbutus Lake.

FAST BOATING TIMES AND LOCATIONS

KEY While Access Areas

Public Shoreline

High-speed boating and water skiing permitted 11:00 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.

Fast boating is permitted in Lakes 2, 3, and 4. No-wake zones are clearly marked either by buoys or signage. Failure to comply may result in the issuance of a

ticket/fine from the Sherrif's Department. Fines begin at \$150 and may vary on a case-by-case basis.

High-Speed Boating is prohibited in Lakes 1 and 5.

When using the Lake, boats are to travel in a counter-clockwise direction in order to keep boat traffic moving efficiently and safely.

The ALA asks that you please be considerate to other boaters. and avoid blocking the channels between lakes.

Public Shoreline and Picnic Areas have been marked clearly on the map to the right.

Please avoid pulling your boat up on and using private shoreline around the lake.
